General Information

Membership

A security deposit of \$1000 per family is required when membership is accepted.

A total food minimum of \$650 must be spent in the Dining Room and in the Snack Bar. If the minimum is not spent, it will be charge to your account. (The 20% service charge & NYS tax is additional to the food minimum.)

The security deposit paid by the member at this date may be commingled by the agent with its other funds, shall not bear interest, shall not be applied against rent or food charges, and shall be returned to the member upon the peaceful termination of the full term of this agreement. Such security deposit shall be returned after deducting there from the cost of any repairs which have been occasioned by acts of the member.

All security deposits are returnable by 1/31 of the following year provided resignations are received in writing by 12/31.

- 1) *Payment in full by April 1st of membership dues is required before admission to Club grounds and use of the facilities. Tennis courts open April 1st through December 1st, weather permitting. All boaters must remove their boats from the slip by October 31st.*
- 2) *Membership cards must be presented at Club entrance and car-parking sticker shall be affixed to window.*
- 3) *Membership cards are not transferable. Any attempt to transfer may result in forfeiture of membership.*

Guests

- 1) *A member in good standing must accompany guests. Member shall register guest and shall be responsible for guest fee & conduct of guest.*
- 2) *Member will sign chit for guest fee and register guest at guardhouse. (Signed and dated Chits will be billed monthly – they are not negotiable). Members are allowed to have the Same guest once a month. (That same guest cannot be invited in the same month by any other member).*
- 3) *Guest fees are posted:
Monday – Thursday - \$15 Friday - \$20 Weekends & Holidays - \$30
Children under 12 – Monday –Friday - \$10 Weekends & Holidays - \$20*
- 4) *The Board of Governors reserves the right to restrict or withdraw guest privileges at any time.*

Parking

- 1) *Cars must park in designated areas. Parking sticker on car required.*
- 2) *Each family is entitled to one (1)-parking sticker. Additional parking stickers are available at an additional cost.*
- 3) *Members park their cars at their own risk. MBYC is not responsible for damage to cars or for personal property in vehicle.*

Pool & Beach Regulations

- 1) *Swimming permitted only when lifeguard on duty.
Pool Hours: Monday – Friday – 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
Weekends – 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.*
- 2) *Lifeguard on duty will determine rules pertaining to safety in and out of the water. Failure to allow regulations regarding safety may lead to suspension of membership.*
- 3) *Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests.*
- 4) *Swimming prohibited when there is no lifeguard on duty!*
- 5) *Children under 7 must be accompanied by adult supervision on beach or at the pool area.*
- 6) *Fishing is not permitted from the beach, dock or on the rocks.*
- 7) *MBYC is not responsible for any damage or loss sustained.*
- 8) *Cabanas may not be opened after 6 p.m. weekdays and 7 p.m. on Saturday & Sunday.*

Liability

- 1) *The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage to automobile or other property of any member or guest.*
- 2) *All personal property must be removed from the premises at the time designated at the close of the season.*

Additional Information

- 1) *Outside food and drink are not allowed on Club premises. (This includes cabanas & cabinettes).*
- 2) *No cooking or use of electrical items in the cabanas. Radios may be used with earplugs.*
- 3) *Bicycles are not allowed on Club property.*
- 4) *Dogs or other animals **are not permitted on Club grounds.***
- 5) *Ball playing in designated areas only.*
- 6) *Beach chairs and umbrellas are provided by the Club.*

House Rules

- 1) *Members & guests require proper and appropriate attire when in the main Clubhouse.*
- 2) *Appropriate cover-ups over bathing suits and shoes are required when at the Pavilion or in the main Clubhouse.*
- 3) *Noisy or disorderly conduct will not be permitted on the Club premises.*
- 4) *The Board of Governors shall have the right to suspend or expel any member for conduct, which in its opinion is contrary to the best interests of the Club.*
- 5) *The Board of Governors reserves the right to suspend or withdraw or add to any or all of these rules at any time which in its judgment is in the best interest of the Club.*
- 6) *Members must sign all charges. The person in charge may sign a charge incurred, but not signed, and will be payable as though signed by that member.*
